Information Booklet

Regulations for admission to M.Sc. Nursing/(WBPGNAT-2018) Post Basic B.Sc / (WBNAT-2018)

Nursing 2018

1. Jurisdiction of the University

- 1.1. Admission to the seats in the affiliated institutions of The West Bengal University of Health Sciences (WBUHS) in different NURSING Courses shall be made on the basis of the inter se merit lists of different categories/ castes of candidates.
- 1.2 M. Sc. NURSING: On the basis of the results of the West Bengal Post Graduate NURSING Admission Test Examination (WBPGNAT - 2018) to be conducted by WBUHS. This is a full time (regular) 2 yrs course.
- 1.3 **POST BASIC B. Sc. NURSING:** On the basis of the results of the West Bengal NURSING Admission Test Examination (WBNAT 2018) to be conducted by the WBUHS. This is a full time (regular) 2 yrs course.

2. Eligibility criteria

- 2.1 Citizens of India who have obtained the following qualifications shall be eligible to apply for the respective courses. In-service candidates of Government of West Bengal has to study carefully 'The West Bengal Nursing Personnel (Placement on Trainee Reserve) Rules 2009' (Annexure-III in this booklet) before applying. She has to be sure whether she is eligible for the facilities provided in such Rules. Mere getting qualifying marks will not make her eligible for entry for an in-service candidate. Placement on trainee reserve is a prerogative exclusive of govt. of West Bengal. State Government decides specific number of trainees considering large number of issues involved in Health Care Delivery System in the State. Such decision of fixing number of trainees is binding to all stake holder.
- M. Sc. NURSING: B. Sc. Degree in Nursing / B. Sc. (Hons.) Degree in Nursing/ Post Basic B. Sc. Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. (Hons) with minimum of 55% marks in aggregate in the above examinations from any Institution recognized by Indian Nursing Council (INC). The candidate must have minimum one year of working experience on last date of application after passing Basic B.Sc. Nursing/ B.Sc (Hons.) Nursing. For candidates with Post Basic B.Sc Degree minimum one year of working experience is required prior or after obtaining the degree of Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing. Candidates who have acquired degree of B.Sc/ Post Basic B.Sc Nursing through Distance Education are not eligible for M.Sc. Nursing Programme if the study centers are not recognized by INC. Two years of working experience is required for such candidates who obtained their degree through Distance Education.

- 2.3 POST BASIC B. Sc. NURSING: The candidate must have:
 - i) passed Higher Secondary (10+2) or an equivalent examination (those who have passed 10+1 before 1978 are also eligible to apply) and
 - ii) Passed GNM examination and obtained GNM certificate/ RNRM certificate registered by the State Nursing Council of any State of India.

3. Method of Submission of application.

See **Annexure-III** of this document

4. Admission test

- 4.1 Two separate Admission tests will be conducted by the WBUHS for the candidates seeking admission to the M. Sc. NURSING Course and POST BASIC B. Sc. NURSING Course.
- 4.2 Applicant for admission will be provisionally allowed to appear in the Admission test provided she has submitted her application in the prescribed form as per **Guidelines for Submission of Application** (page-10) and has fulfilled the eligibility criteria outlined above within last date of application.
- 4.3 The question papers for the Admission tests shall be set in English and each shall contain 100 single best response type Multiple Choice Questions.
- 4.4 The duration of the Admission test will be of 80 minutes.
- 4.5 The following is the list showing the approximate number of questions from different Clinical subjects & Non-clinical subjects which will be set in the Admission tests for the following courses:

1. POST BASIC B. Sc. NURSING:

a) Anatomy, Physiology, Sociology, Psychology.

Pharmacology, Microbiology, Nutrition, Pathology-40 Nos. [8x5]

b) Foundation of Nursing, Medical Surgical Nursing, Paediatric Nursing, Psychiatric Nursing, Obstetrical Nursing, Community Health Nursing - 60 Nos. [6x10]

2. M. Sc. NURSING course:

a) A natomy, Physiology, Sociology, Psychology, Microbiology, Pathology,

Pharmacology, Genetics, Administration, Education, Research & Statistics - 40 Nos.

- b) Foundation of Nursing, Medical Surgical Nursing, Paediatric Nursing, Psychiatric Nursing, Obstetrical Nursing, Community Health Nursing 60 Nos. [6x10]
- 4.6 For both the examination a candidate will be awarded one (1) mark for each correct answer and no mark will be deducted for incorrect answer.
- 4.7 Multiple answers will be regarded as incorrect answer.

4.8 The candidates will able to access their rank from the university website citing their acknowledgement number.

5. Merit list of candidates

- 5.1 The rank of the candidates will be determined on the basis of the marks obtained by them in the admission test in order of decreasing marks.
- 5.2 In the event of more than one candidate securing the same mark, the rank shall be determined according to the following principles:
 - i. The relative position of such candidates will be determined on the basis of the number of wrong answers, i.e., the candidate giving more incorrect answers will be placed in lower position in the merit list.
 - ii. If the ranks of the candidates cannot be determined by application of the above principle, the candidate older by age will be in the higher rank than the candidate younger by age.
- 5.3 The candidates will able to access their rank from the university website citing their acknowledgement number.
- 5.4 Reservation for OBC-A,OBC-B, if any, will be applicable as per laws existing at the point of counselling. For Physically Challenged candidate horizontal reservation will be allowed. However seats at N.I.L.D, OBC share of seat remain as per GOI Reservation Rules.
- 5.5 Prior to appearing at the written test, no document is verified; therefore mere appearing at examination will not qualify a person for getting admission if she is otherwise ineligible.

6. Counseling for selection of candidates for admission

- 6.1 Separate Counseling will be held for M.Sc. Nursing & Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing. Admission to M.Sc. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing in different Institutions will be made through online counselling. Details about counseling will be made available in the university website, www.wbuhs.ac.in/ www.wbuhsexams.in along with the results. The candidates will be called in order of merit.
- 6.2 The provisional merit list as well schedule of counseling will be available at the website. No separate information will be sent to individual candidate in this regard. In case, on line counseling is not organized, offline counseling will be arranged. The candidate is required to visit website www.wbuhsexams.in for the latest information.
- 6.3 The university will decide process of counseling later on.

- 6.4 During admission following documents be produced at the college:
 - (i) Admit Card of the Admission Test in original
 - (ii) Mark-sheet(s) of qualifying examination and Provisional/Final passing certificate in original. For aspirants in M.Sc. Course, separate subject wise marks are also to be submitted to facilitate the checking for qualifying marks obtained by the candidates.
 - (iii) Registration Certificate issued by State Registration Council.
 - (iv) Proof of age, e.g., Admit card or Certificate of Madhyamik or equivalent examination
 - (v) Working experience certificate from the competent authority as mentioned in paragraph. **2.2** for M.Sc course
 - (vi) OBC-A/OBC-B/SC/ST/ certificate if applicable / Physically Challanged certificate showing percentage and location of disability issued by the designated board at I.P.G.M.E.R. OBC, OBC-A, OBC-B certificate must ratify the present income of the family i.e. the income after 01.01.2017 to substantiate that candidate is from non creamy layer.
 - (vii) In- service candidates (E.S.I, Central Government, West Bengal Government, other State Government or employed under any Private Establishment and any other autonomous bodies receiving funds from State Government/Central Government) has to furnish 'No Objection' certificate in respect of her current status during counseling. Other candidates also will produce the relieving order of last working institution.
 - (viii) Any other relevant document.
 - (Reservation policy will be followed as applicable during the period of counseling)
- 6.5 The number of seats available for allotment, with their subject-wise break-up, will be displayed at the venue of counseling. Information in this regard may also be available in the concerned colleges.
- 6.6 The candidates will have the right to choose any one of the available seats at her rank at that point of time and the same will be allotted to her.
- 6.7 The allotment made by the WBUHS will be final. Change of subject/ institution is not permitted. Therefore, request for the same will not be entertained by the WBUHS after the allotment.
- 6.8 The applicants who are regular staff of government of West Bengal are to get admission and pursue study provided they are considered as "Trainee Reserve" categories by the government of West Bengal in the Health and Family Welfare Department. The Candidate should not have any claim for her admission for pursuing the course based on eligibility if she is not considered as 'Trainee Reserve' by the Government of West Bengal.

6.9. Candidates are to appear at examination on the basis of her own declaration. If it is found that she is ineligible for not fulfilling any condition, she is not authorized to state that she has not been alerted before appearing at examination for her being non-eligible and she will not be considered for admission even if she figures in the merit list. She will study carefully the booklet before filling up form and pay examination fees through bank draft.

7. Reservation of Seats

- 7.1 Seats shall be kept reserved as per policy of State Government during the period of counseling. Physically Challenged means Persons with disabilities as defined by Medical Council of India, i.e., 50-70% loco- motor disability in lower limb(s) only and in case candidates are not available in the category as stated, then only candidates with the disability of lower limbs between 40% to 50% be considered for admission. The Government order and/ or the court directives which will be in force on the respective day of counseling will be followed. Roster will be followed by the University for this purpose.
- 7.2. Seats reserved for SC candidates when remaining vacant even after following the instructions laid down in the Govt. orders and notifications, shall be filled in by the ST candidates and vice-versa. If the seats which were reserved for SC and ST candidates remain vacant and no more candidates are available, such seats will be opened for General Candidates.
- 7.3 Physically Challenged candidates will be allotted seats based on policy of horizontal reservation.
- 7.4 Candidates of other states irrespective of the Reservation status will be treated as General (unreserved category) category candidate. However seat at N.I.L.D will be filled up by GOI Rules and SC/ST/OBC candidates for other states will be considered provided status rank permits.

8. Other information

- 8.1 Candidate will obtain print out after submission of application for sign on it, put LTI and attach bank draft/Pay order in favour of 'The West Bengal University of Health Sciences'
- 8.2 Candidates need not submit any supporting document except an identity proof along with their application form. Copy of EPIC, relevant page of Passport or PAN Card be submitted.
- 8.3 The allotment of examination centre will be done by the WBUHS and will be final and binding on the candidate.
- 8.4 There is no provision for rechecking/ re-evaluation of the answer sheet [which is one page Optical Mark Recognition(OMR) sheet] and no query in this regard will be entertained.

ANNEXURE-II

GENERAL RULES AND PROCEDURAL DIRECTIVES

Candidate is requested to read carefully all instruction. Incorrect filling of data in the form will disqualify a candidate in appearing at entrance examination and bank draft sent shall forfeited:

- 1. Applicants should go through and strictly follow the instructions given in the Information Booklet for Nursing Courses as published in www.wbuhs.ac.in / www.wbuhsexams.in , while applying for different courses. Application must be complete in all respect.
- 2. All application are to be submitted online as per guidelines first then two more pages will come with an Acknowledgement number, which will be submitted to the WBUHS with required documents by post. Candidates will note the Acknowledge Number for its use till the admission over.
- 3. The Print-copy of the application submitted personally at the office of Controller of Examination of the University or by speed-post in the address of "Controller of Examinations, The West Bengal University of Health Sciences , DD-36, Salt Lake, Sector-1, Kolkata-700064", The application must reach the office of the WBUHS within 04.07.2018 in person and 06.07.2018 by speed post.
 - a. M. Sc. NURSING: Rs.3000/-
 - b. POST BASIC course for the degree of POST BASIC B. Sc. NURSING: Rs.2000/-
- 4. No other document except Demand Draft and copy of Election Photo Identity Card / PAN Card/Passport is to be submitted with application form.
- 5. Submission of incorrect or false statements / documents or suppression of material information in the application form will be considered as sufficient ground for cancellation of the candidature or the admission of the candidates to a course whenever detected, i.e. during the process of admission or even at any stage thereafter.
- 6. The selection / admission of a candidate shall stand cancelled if she is found guilty of copying from any material whatsoever or of taking the help of any electronic media/devices during the examination, or of assisting others or of being assisted by others in any manner whatsoever in writing out the answers during the examination. In this context, decision of the Centre-in-charge will be final and binding.
- 7. Admit Card will have to be downloaded on and from date specified in the schedule for admission test 2018.
- 8. Multiple Choice answers will be through OMR will be scanned. Candidate should be accustomed thoroughly with the system. Scanned copy of the OMR sheet and instructions for filling it are enclosed herewith.

- 9. The qualified candidate whose names will be published in the Provisional Merit List, is to submit all the attested copies of supporting documents along with originals for verification of their eligibility to the course during counseling.
- 10. The Merit list along with the date, time and venue of counseling will be available in the website www.wbuhsexams.in/ <a href="https://www.wbu

- *1. A candidate seeking admission through WBPGNAT/WBNAT is required to submit her application **online** by logging in www.wbuhs.ac.in Application submitted by all other means will be summarily rejected.
- *2. The candidate will, first of all, visit the university website www.wbuhsexams.in/www.wbuhs.ac.in. through internet. He/She is required to go through the relevant 'Information Booklet' carefully and acquaint himself/herself with all requirements regarding filling in the application form.
- *3. At the left Hand Side of the homepage click on "Online Application", then select for WBPGNAT/WBNAT 2017 from the drop down menu.
- *4. Fill in the 'Online Application Form' carefully by selecting appropriate options or by typing in appropriate places. Please do not skip any point. Then click "view" at the bottom of the page to see what you have entered.
- *5. Please check the details of your entry in the next page. If you want to change anything click 'Back' at the bottom to go to the previous page to make necessary corrections and then again click 'view'.

- Step 4 : Put your full signature in the box provided.


(B) Answer sheet (on the right hand side): Please be careful while filling up OMR Sheet:








NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India the Governor is pleased hereby to make the following rules namely:—

Rules

- 1. Short title and commencement :-
 - (1) These rules may be called the West Bengal Nursing Personnel (Placement on Trainee Reserve) Rules, 2009.
 - (2) These rules shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette,
- 2. Application of the rules— These rules shall be applicable for all categories of nursing personnel employed in the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of West Bengal, and borne in the cadres of the West Bengal Nursing Service, the West Bengal General Service and shall also include such other nursing personnel posted as Health Assistant (Female) and Health Supervisor (Female).
- 3. Admissible courses of study and number of trainee reserve— (1) Nursing Personnel shall, subject to the condition laid down in these rules, be eligible to be placed on trainee reserve for admission to the courses as mentioned hereunder:—

- (2) The exact number of candidates to be placed on trainee reserve for the different courses run by the West Bengal Nursing Council, West Bengal University of Health Sciences and other Universities, in respect of the concerned nursing personnel for whom these rule are applicable, shall, by order, be determined by the State Government from time to time.
- 4. Criteria for placement on trainee reserve.— The following shall be the eligibility criteria for placement on trainee reserve as Government sponsored candidates:—
 - (a) for the Nursing Personnel borne in the cadres of the West Bengal Nursing Service, West Bengal General Service and for those nursing personnel employed in the posts of Health Assistant (Female) or Health Supervisor (Female)—
 - (i) a minimum of three years qualifying service under the employment of the Government of West Bengal in the respective cadre or a total service of three years taking into account the service rendered in the West Bengal Nursing Service, West Bengal General Service and/or in the post of Health Assistant (Female) and/ or Health Supervisor (Female) taken together, the qualifying service being determined as on the last date of submission of application prescribed by the concerned institution or Nursing Council or University for undergoing the courses mentioned in rule 3;
 - (ii) nursing Personnel who had acquired or passed Auxiliary Nurse Midwifery (Revised) Course or General-Nursing Midwifery Course or B.Sc. Nursing or M.Sc. Nursing or M. Phil Nursing, irrespective of the fact whether the same was acquired with or without Government sponsorship prior to entry in Government Service, shall only be entitled to undergo corresponding higher course i.e. General Nursing Midwifery Course, B.Sc. Nursing Course, M.Sc. Nursing Course, M. Phil in Nursing, as the case may be;
 - (iii) nursing Personnel once placed on trainee reserve for prosecuting any course in such manner as laid down in sub-clause-(ii) of this clause shall not be allowed any other facilities of trainee reserve for prosecuting similar course in any other discipline unless permitted by the State Government in the exigencies of Public Services;
 - (iv) the nursing personnel must not be more than 53 years of age on the last date of submission of application for admission. However, no nursing personnel shall be eligible for trainee reserve in excess of a total period of 7 years during her entire service tenure;
 - (v) for placement on trainee reserve for undergoing General-Nursing Midwifery, B.Sc.(Nursing), post-graduate degree or M. Phil courses in Nursing, other eligibility criteria, as may be prescribed by the concerned University or Council or Institution within or outside the State shall also determine the eligibility for being placed on trainee reserve in addition to the foregoing criteria.
- 5. Execution of bond,—(1) Nursing Personnel shall have to execute a bond in triplicate prior to proceeding on trainee reserve, to such effect that she shall serve this State Government for a minimum period of three years for course of duration of two-years or less, and five years for courses of duration of three years or more on completion of the course as trainee reserve, failing which, such Nursing Personnel shall refund to the State Government the amount of money, in the manner prescribed below:—
 - (i) for courses of duration of more than 2 years-three Lakh rupees,
 - (ii) for courses of duration of two years -- two Lakh rupees;
 - (c) for courses of duration of less than two years one Lakh.
 - (2) No Nursing Personnel shall be allowed to resign or retire voluntarily or deputed to any other service or to be placed on lien, during the period of service required in the bond unless she has paid such amount as specified in subrule (1) of this rule.



- (3) Any Nursing Personnel who discontinues or drops out of any course in which she had been placed on trainee reserve, shall forgo any further privilege of being placed on trainee reserve, and the period which she has spent on trainee reserve shall be adjusted against her admissible leave.
- 6. Procedure for application and placement on trainee reserve,— The following shall be the procedure for applying and placement on trainee reserve:—

the Nursing Personnel when eligible under the foregoing rules can directly apply to any University or Institution for appearing in the Diploma Course (General Nursing Midwifery), graduate and post-graduate and M.Phil, entrance Examination and simultaneously shall apply to the Director of Health Services for sponsorship certificates. After observing required formalities in accordance with law, the placement orders for trainee reserve will be issued and thereafter such personnel will proceed on trainee reserve and execute bonds as specified in rule 4 of the rules.

7. Eligibility for further Government sponsorship.—

Any Nursing Personnel, after successful completion of one course by availing "Trainee Reserve" facility and after serving the mandatory period as per bond executed by her, shall only be eligible for further Government sponsorship as "Trainee Reserve" for higher Course and Super speciality course.

8. Bar to study and trainee reserve other than approved by the State Government.—

No Nursing Personnel shall be allowed to undergo studies as trainee reserve in any manner other than being sponsored as per these rules. However, for short duration training courses, the State Government may allow sponsorship and place such nursing personnel on trainee reserve, or, allow such officer to undergo such course by availing admissible leave as felt expedient by the Government in accordance with the provisions contained in rule 6 of these rules.
