'Fundamentals in Abdomino-Pelvic Ultra Sonography : Level one
for MBBS Doctors' under PC-PNDT Act, in West Bengal**

2018

Certificate Course

1. Jurisdiction of the University

- 1.1. Admission to the seats in the affiliated institution of The West Bengal University of Health Sciences shall be made on the basis of the inter se merit positions of different categories/ castes of candidates appearing in the “ **Six Months Certificate Course on Training on Abdomino-Pelvic Ultra Sonography – Level one for MBBS Doctors in West Bengal** ” Examination to be conducted by the West Bengal University of Health Sciences (WBUHS).

2. Eligibility criteria

- a. Citizens of India and resident of West Bengal who have obtained the MBBS Degree from any university of the country duly recognized by the Medical Council of India.
- b. Application for admission to Certificate Course will not be accepted unless the candidates have got themselves registered with the MCI or WBMC.
- c. Candidates who are already pursuing any other course are not eligible for admission. However, candidates completing the course/resigning from the course before the date of admission, will be eligible to get admission.
- d. Candidates qualified in NEETPG-2018 are eligible to apply. Selection will be based on the rank in merit list of NEET PG – 2018.

3. Selection procedure

Candidates qualified in NEETPG-2018 are eligible to apply. Selection will be based on the rank in merit list of NEET PG 2018.

4. No. of seats: Fifty One (51). Forty One (41) candidates will be considered from open category and Ten (10) candidates will be from in-service category.

5. Counseling for selection of candidates for admissions

Counselling for allotment of college will be done at the University and date and venue will be informed in the website later on.

6. Reservation of Seats

6.1 Seats shall be kept reserved for the OBC-A, OBC-B SC, ST & Physically Challenged candidates respectively. 'Physically Challenged' means 'Persons with disabilities as defined by MCI, i.e., 50%-70% loco motor disability in lower limb(s)' only and certified by physical medicine department of IPGMER, Kolkata-700020. The government order and/ or the court directives which will be in force on the respective day of counseling will be followed for this purpose.

6.2 Reservation policy of SC and ST seats will not be applicable for the students of other states. Seats reserved for SC candidates when remaining vacant even after following the instructions laid down in the Govt. orders and notifications, shall be filled in by the ST candidates and vice-versa.

6.3 Seats reserved for PC candidates when remaining vacant even after following the instructions laid down in the Govt. orders and notifications, shall be filled in from the general merit position.

6.4 If "Reserved Category Candidates (SC and ST)" qualifies with the same standard followed for General Category candidates, will be treated as General Category Candidate, provided he/she opts for the same. For such, seat from General category will be adjusted. The seat so becoming available, will be counseled for next candidate in the roster while the reserved seats for SC and ST candidates will remain same. On the contrary, if she/he opts for reserved seat, it will be adjusted in the reserved category and counted as part of the reserved pool for the purpose of computing the aggregate reservation.

7. Other information

7.1. Candidates need not submit any supporting document along with their application form.

7.2. The allotment of Institute will be done by the WBUHS and will be final and binding.

7.3. The in-service candidates may submit applications directly, but "No Objection Certificate/ Sponsoring Certificate" by competent authority must be submitted at the time of counseling.

7.4 Leave or placement on training for the in-service candidates is the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent authority of the H&FW Department. Mere selection will not qualify a candidate to join the course.

7.6 Candidates of both the category are expected, preferably, not to apply for PGNEET-2019

7.7 Course Fees Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) to be submitted to the Health & Family Welfare Department, Govt. of West Bengal through Bank Draft in favour of *"West Bengal State Health & Family Welfare Samiti"*, payable at Kolkata.

GENERAL RULES AND PROCEDURAL DIRECTIVES

1. Applicants should go through and strictly follow the instructions given in the Information Booklet as published in www.wbuhs.ac.in / www.wbuhsexams.in
2. The Print-copy of the application must reach the office of the 'Controller of Examinations', West Bengal University of Health Sciences, DD- 36, Sector- I, Salt Lake, Kolkata-700064 within 24.07.2018 by hand and 26.07.2018 by speed post/registered post.
3. No document is to be submitted with application form. Such document will be verified at the time of final selection.
4. Submission of incorrect or false statements / documents or suppression of material information in the application form will be considered as sufficient ground for cancellation of the candidature or the admission of the candidates to the course whenever detected, i.e. during the process of admission or even at any stage thereafter.
5. Candidates in order of merit will be called for counseling and list of such candidates will have to bring bank draft/ bankers cheque of Rs. 3000/- drawn in favour of "*The West Bengal University of Health Sciences*" payable at Kolkata. Those who are not allotted seats in counselling are not required to submit bank draft.
6. The Merit position and the date, time and venue of counseling and subsequent admission will be notified in the website of the WBUHS < www.wbuhs.ac.in/ www.wbuhsexams.in/ www.wbhealth.gov.in >. No communication in this regard will be made to the candidates personally.

7. Candidates selected through counseling for admission shall have to get themselves admitted within the specified date to be mentioned in the offer letter to be issued after counseling. Admission will be completed after submission of course fee. Course fee to be submitted to the Health and Family Welfare Dept. , Govt. of West Bengal through bank draft in favour of "*West Bengal State Health & Family Welfare Samiti*", payable at Kolkata.
8. If a candidate does not report to the allotted institution by the due date his / her admission to the course will be cancelled.
9. No travel allowance is admissible for appearing in counseling.
10. No personal communication will be made to the candidates, unless it is considered absolutely necessary by the University authority.
