Candidates are required to bring the following documents in original for verification to participate in the counseling:

1. **In-service candidates (E.S.I, Central Government, West Bengal Government, other State Government or employed under any private establishment and any other autonomous bodies receiving funds from State Government) has to furnish 'No Objection Certificate' in respect of his/her current status during counseling. Other candidates will produce the relieving order of last working institution.**

- Reservation will be done as per the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2013.
- Roster points will start immediate after the serial where it ended in last academic session.
- **Seats reserved for SC candidates when remaining vacant even after following the instruction laid down in the Govt. orders and notifications; shall be filled in by the ST candidates and vice versa. If the seats which were reserved for SC and ST candidates remain vacant and no more candidates are available such seats will be opened for General Candidates.**
- Candidates of other State irrespective of the reservation status will be treated as General (unreserved) Category candidates. Rules of SC/ST/OBC candidates for other states will be treated as unreserved candidates.
- Candidates who remain absent till the seats are available in the first counseling is not eligible to attend second counseling (if required). However, candidate who is not accommodated in the first counseling due to non-availability of seats will be eligible for next counseling. Candidates, if desirous may be represented any authorized person but he/she should possess minimum knowledge in respect of process of counseling. Before being represented by other than the candidate himself/herself, one should get permission from authority of the Institute of Public Health, Kalyani (IPHK).
- **Candidates are to pay the counseling fee of Rs. 3,000/- before the counseling. If they already have paid the same during the first counseling and have not been refunded it, they are to show the receipt of the fees.**
- If any candidate (other than sponsored) discontinues the course in the midway, he/she should be liable to deposit the total stipend received from IPHK and Rs. 2 lakh (Two lakh). Each candidate (other than sponsored) should sign a Bond accordingly at the time of taking admission.
- The selected candidates should take admission on the admission on the same day of counseling at the IPHK office, otherwise his/her candidature as well as allotment will stand cancelled automatically.
- Extended First-round of counseling may continue to the next day if any vacancy occurred due to non admission of selected candidates.
- The condition regarding bond other requirement is strictly binding on admitted candidate.
