



NOTICE

This is to inform all intending candidates willing to pursue **M. Phil in Psychiatric Social Work** course for the academic session 2018 -2019; at the **Institute of Psychiatry**, Kolkata under the West Bengal University of Health Sciences; that:

The admission test for the said course will be conducted by the University for the candidates who have submitted their applications at the Institute of Psychiatry. The following are salient points about the admission test:

1. Eligibility to appear at the test is a M.S.W/M.A. degree in Social Work from any University recognized by the UGC with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate (for General candidates) or 50% marks in aggregate (for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B candidates).
2. The test will be conducted on **29th December, at 12 noon** at the premises of the University. All candidates will have to enter the examination hall latest by 11-45 a.m.
2. The admission test will be based on a written test through MCQs. There will be **80 single-best-response-type MCQs**; to be completed within 60 minutes.
3. The candidates will be distributed the admit cards to sit for the examination on production of the same I.D. proof they had submitted along with their applications to the University officials one hour before the commencement of the examination.
4. Allotment of seats to the different categories will be done at a counseling session based on a merit list prepared out of the marks obtained in the written test.
5. Out of the total 16 seats, 5 seats will be reserved for SC candidates, 1 seat for ST candidates, 1 seat for OBC-A candidates and 1 seat for OBC-B candidates.
6. The results of the test will be available in the official website of the University www.wbuhs.ac.in and the candidates are to attend the subsequent counseling for verification of testimonials and allotment of seats based on the notice published there in on payment of the counseling fee. No communication will be made to the candidates through any other mode.
