

Admission requirements

In order to be admitted to the Master of Bioethics, applicants should be holders of a master's degree - permissible degrees are medicine, biology, nursing sciences, political sciences, theology, philosophy, psychology, sociology, economics, law. Applicants are required to demonstrate their proficiency in English, either by proving that some of their previous studies were successfully completed in English, or by submitting the results of a recognised language proficiency test such as IELTS or TOEFL.
