

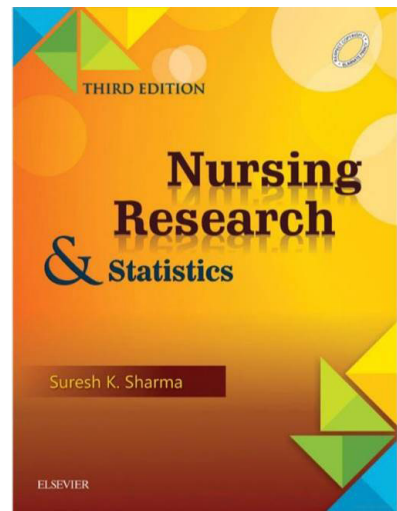
BOOK REVIEW
