## NOTICE

It is hereby informed to all intending candidates for Fellowship in Pain Management course (Academic session 2021 – 2022) in the different institutions under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences that applications are invited from the MBBS graduates from any University recognized in India and having registration either with the state or MCI in the format provided below.

The admission to the course will be through an interview that will be conducted by senior faculty members of the field specifically formed by the WBUHS for the purpose.

Fellowship in Pain Management is a 12 month, full-time, residential course. The question of allowance of the in-service candidates for Trainee Reserve facility by the Govt. of West Bengal rests entirely with the State Govt. All in-service candidates will have to produce a no-objection certificate from the employing authority at the time of counseling for the course, if their names appear in the provisional merit list published by the University after the interview. The reservation policy into SC / ST/ OBC-A / OBC-B will be applicable in accordance with the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2013.

The date and time of the interview along with the eligible candidates to appear at the Interview will be notified in the website of WBUHS in due course. Applicant for admission will be provisionally allowed to appear in the interview provided he/she has submitted applications in the prescribed form and has fulfilled the eligibility criteria outlined above. Mere appearing at the interview do not guarantee admission if otherwise the candidate is found ineligible in latter stages of the admission procedure; even after the admission itself.
