NOTICE

The following is notified for intending candidates appearing for Research Aptitude Test (RAT) 2021 toward Ph. D Admission under the West Bengal University of Health Sciences.

- 1. The written test will be held on Saturday, the 26th February, 2022 at 12 noon at the University premises. The candidates are required to attend to the examination hall half an hour prior to the beginning of the examination and no candidate will be allowed to enter the hall after ten minutes of it.
- 2. The examination will be of one hour in duration during which no candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall under any circumstances even if the candidate has finished the examination.
- 3. The candidate will have to carry a valid photo ID (such as Passport / AADHAR Card / Voter ID / Driving License) which will have to be produced to the invigilator at the examination hall.
- 4. The candidate can only carry the admit card for the test and the photo ID in the examination hall. The OMR sheet, question paper and the ball point pen – all will be supplied from the University.
- 5. The candidates are instructed to write their roll nos. and series no. of the question booklet very carefully on the OMR sheet and blacken the corresponding circles. They will put their full signature over the OMR sheet. Candidates must remember that the OMR sheets are not replaced under any circumstances. So they should be handing it cautiously so that it does not get damaged or soiled in any respect and blotted with ink on anywhere of it. This can hamper the scanning of the OMR sheets.
- 6. The examinations will be of single best response type MCQs set in English language. Correct response to each of the questions will carry one mark. Half marks will be deducted for each incorrect response. Multiple responses to any question will be regarded as wrong. No marks will be deducted for questions not answered.
- 7. There will be sixty MCQs in the question paper; divided into two parts: Group A Research Methodology (40 MCQs) and Group B - Domain (viz. Medicine, Dental, Homoeopathy, Ayurveda, Nursing and Allied & Paramedical) Specific MCQs (20 MCQs).
- 8. The candidates are advised to be careful enough to blacken the circles on the OMR sheet as their choice of response. The entire circle will have to be blackened, though the candidate need not be artistic in doing so. There is no possibility to change the response on the OMR sheet as blackening of more than one circle will mean double response and will automatically be scanned as wrong response.
- 8. The admit card will be downloaded from the portal of the candidates themselves and will be available from 2ist February, 2022; 10-00 a.m.
