Notice For Admission To MSc Laboratory Technology in Immuno Hematology and Blood Banking

It is hereby notified to all concerned that the University has decided to hold an admission procedure to admit candidate for the MSc Laboratory Technology in Immuno Hematology and Blood Banking course for the academic session 2023 – 2025 according to the regulations mentioned hereunder. Intending candidates are instructed to go through the notification carefully.

1. Jurisdiction of the University:

Admission to the seats in Two years M.Sc. MLT in Immuno Hematology & Blood Banking course to be conducted by the West Bengal University of Health Sciences (WBUHS) shall be made on the basis of inter-se merit list of different categories/caste of candidates.

2. Eligibility criteria:

- a. Citizens of India who have obtained B.Sc. MLT or BMLT degree with duly completing their stipulated internship from any recognized University shall be eligible to apply for the course.
- b. Candidates who are already pursuing any other course are not eligible for admission. However, candidates completing the course or resigning from the course before the date of counseling will be eligible to get admission.
- c. The course will consider PWD candidates as eligible if they certify their disability to between 40% 70% in the lower limb only. The extent of disability will have to be certified from the Dept. of Physical Medicine, IPGME&R for admission.

3. Filling up of forms:

Applications will be sought offline as appended at the end of this notification. Candidates will have to submit a demand draft of **Rs. 5000/- (Rs. Five thousand only)** in favour of "The West Bengal University of Health Sciences", payable at Kolkata along with the application. All candidates are instructed to **submit selfattested photocopy of all the relevant documents especially the marksheet(s) / Certificate of the BScMLT examination(s)** and keep a photocopy of the application form with them duly signed by the personnel receiving the application. The candidates sending the application by post must keep the document of posting the application. The received copy of the application will serve as the proof of submission which will be needed at the time of counseling. The University will not take any responsibility of the applications lost in transit or delivered after the due date.

4. Institution and Available Seats:

M.Sc. MLT in Immuno Hematology & Blood Banking course is affiliated to WBUHS for conduct at **Haldia Institute of Health Sciences**, Hatiberia, Haldia, Purba Medinipur721657, with a capacity of **Thirty (30) unreserved** seats.

5. Admission Test :

a) The written test will be held at the University premises or anywhere else as detailed in the admit card at time and date enumerated later in this document and as instructed in the admit card. The candidates are required to attend to the examination hall half an hour prior to the beginning of the examination and no candidate will be allowed to enter the hall after examination commences.

b) The examination will be of one hour and twenty minutes in duration during which no candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall under any circumstances even if the candidate has finished the examination. They will leave the examination hall only after all the OMRs are collected and duly matched with the attendance sheet.

c) The candidate will have to carry a valid photo ID (such as Passport / AADHAR Card / Voter ID / Driving License) which will have to be produced to the invigilator at the examination hall.

d) The candidate can only carry the admit card for the test and the photo ID in the examination hall. The OMR sheet, question paper and the ball point pen – all will be supplied from the University.

e) The candidates are instructed to write their roll nos. and series & serial no. of the question booklet very carefully on the OMR sheet and blacken the corresponding circles. They will put their Name, Name of the Test, centre of examination and full signature over the OMR sheet. Candidates must remember that the OMR sheets are not replaced under any circumstances. So they should be handling it cautiously so that it does not get damaged or soiled in any respect and blotted with ink on anywhere of it. This can hamper the scanning of the OMR sheets.

f) The examinations will be of single best response type MCQs set in English language. Correct response to each of the questions will carry one mark. There will be no negative marking for wrong answers. However; multiple responses to any question will be regarded as wrong even if any of the options selected was the correct option. No marks will be deducted for questions not answered.

g) There will be one hundred MCQs in the question paper; set on the standard syllabus prescribed for the qualifying examinations.

h) The candidates are advised to be careful enough to blacken the circles on the OMR sheet as their chosen response. The entire circle will have to be blackened, though the candidate need not be artistic in doing so. There is no possibility to change the response on the OMR sheet as blackening of more than one circle will mean double response and will automatically be processed as wrong response.

6. Admit Cards:

The candidates, who have submitted their applications with demand draft, will receive their admit cards

through e mails prior to the admission test by the date written hereunder. Any eligible candidate not receiving the 'admit' must visit the University with the proof of submission of application on the date mentioned for such an event.

7. Merit List:

Merit list will be prepared based on the marks obtained in the admission test.

If two candidates are seen to be tied on the same score, the one with lesser wrong response will be placed higher in the merit list. If the tie cannot be broken in this principle; the one with earlier date of birth will be placed higher in the merit list.

8. Admission:

- a. The provisional merit list as well as the date and time of counseling will be available in the University website.
- b. Offer letter for admission to the course will be given at the time of counseling after successful verification of the testimonials.
- c. The candidates appearing for counseling will have to bring the following documents in original along with selfattested copies at the University premises:
 - Admit card of the admission test.
 - Class10 admit card / Class10 pass certificate as proof of age
 - EPIC / Passport / Aadhar / Diving license as photo identity card.
 - · Marksheets or final certificate of BScMLT examinations
 - Internship completion cettificate
 - Any other relevant documents
- **9.** It is expected that the candidates have ensured that they are eligible to appear in the examination based on the laid down criteria for appearing at the test. There would be no validation of the applications and credentials submitted by the candidates before the test. So if it is found at any stage after the test that there is any discrepancy anywhere in the process of admission, the candidature will be summarily rejected.
- **10.** It is hereby mentioned that all information regarding fees payable or stipends available for the students should always be obtained and confirmed from the individual colleges. WBUHS will not be answerable to any query arising of these issues.
