NOTICE

Counseling for Lateral Entry to Second Year of BSc M L T Course, 2024, Round 2

In continuation to the WBUHS Memo No. OG/WBUHS/2024/0677, dated 16th May, 2024, this is to inform all concerned that the second round of counseling for admission into the presently vacant seats in the second year of B Sc Medical Laboratory Technology (BScMLT) course in the different colleges under the West Bengal, University of Health Sciences will be taken up.

According to the existing norms of counseling, during its second round there will be conversion of seat category based on the principle of SC(PWD) → SC, ST(PWD) → ST, SC ↔ ST, OBC-A(PWD) → OBC-A, OBC-B(PWD) → OBC-B, OBC-A ↔ OBC-B

It is further decided that the counseling will be conducted in three phases.

Phase 1: Allotment of the seats according to rank and exercised choice to the candidates who declined any allotment during round 1 of counselling.

Phase 2: Allotment of the remaining seats according to rank and exercised choice to the candidates who were absent during round 1 of counselling.

Phase 3: Allotment of the remaining seats according to rank and exercised choice to the candidates who did not join the college despite being allotted the seat during round 1 of counselling.

They are hereby instructed to submit an undertaking as to why they did not join the college they were allotted through voluntary exercise of choice. This undertaking will be adjudged by the University authorities about their merit at the time if second round of counselling and any decision regarding allowing or disallowing the candidate to take further part in the counselling will be binding on the candidate.

4. SC/ST/PC/OBC/EWS Certificate from the competent authorities whichever is applicable.
5. The OBC candidates must have a certificate that they do not belong to the creamy layer from the competent authority issued in the current financial year.
