NOTICE

In continuation of the NOTICE PhD program for academic year 2023 – 2024, issued from the Dean Section, WBUHS; following are notified to all applicants; who are not otherwise exempted from appearing for the test; that Research Aptitude Test (RAT) 2024 will be held on **Saturday, the 14th September, 2024 at 12 noon to 1-30 p.m.** (90 min.). The **venue of the examination will be intimated in the admit card** for the examination.

The other salient information about the examinations is:

- Candidates can **download their admit cards from the same link** wherein they had applied for RAT 2023 - 2014 using candidate's own log in ID and password. It will be available **from 10 a.m. on 10th September, 2024.**
- The candidates must enter the examination hall before 30 minutes of beginning of the examination and will not be allowed to leave the hall (even temporarily) till the invigilators allow them to do so at the end of the examination.
- Candidates **must carry the Admit Card and a photo ID** (passport / AADHAR Card / Voter ID / Driving license). No other things will be allowed inside the hall. There must not be any electronic gadget with the candidates (even the mobile phones in 'Switched Off' mode). Pens will be supplied by the University at the examination hall.
- The candidates should be **cautious while entering the Roll No., Booklet No., and Booklet Series and blacken the corresponding circles on the OMR sheet.** The responses of the questions will have to be put on the OMR sheet by blackening the chosen circle in legible and decisive manner without being too artistic. The **OMR sheets are to be handled carefully and will not be replaced** under any circumstances.
- There will be only **one correct response** to each question for which **one mark will be awarded** for correctly choosing it.
- **Half (0.5) marks will be deducted for wrong answers. Multiple responses to a particular question will also be regarded as wrong answer.**
- There will be **100 questions** (MCQs) divided into two parts: Part A comprising of **50 questions on Research Methodology** and Part B comprising of **50 domain specific questions.**
