NOTICE

Sub: Guidelines for the admission to the vacant sets through institute level decentralized counseling for B.Pharm Course for the academic year 2024-25.

The West Bengal Joint Entrance Board (WBJEEB) was entrusted for conducting the entrance examination followed by three rounds of E-Counseling towards admission to B.Pharm course at the different Govt. and Private institutions. After three rounds of counseling; (including the centralized mop-up rounds) a reasonable number of seats are line vacant in the different colleges.

Like previous years Department of Higher Education (Technical Education Branch, Bikash Bhaban, 6th floor, Salt Lake, Kolkata-91) their notification no: 511-Edn(T)/10M-86/15, Dated: 09.12.2024, has instructed about the decentralized institution based counseling and allotment process. All colleges imparting B.Pharm course under WBUHS are hereby instructed to adhere to the following in conduct of the counseling:

A) For Private and Self-financing colleges admission may be allowed on the basis of following priorities

- I) WBJEE rank
- II) All India JEE main rank
- III) 10+2 level results (without any rank from WBJEE & AIJEE)

All the above types of candidates must fulfill the eligibility criteria for admission to B.Pharm course as outlined by the regulatory authority, i.e. PCI.

B) For State Govt. Pharmacy institute candidates should be domiciled in West Bengal only and with WBJEE merit rank.

All the above types of candidates must fulfill the eligibility criteria for admission to B.Pharm course as outlined by the regulatory authority, i.e. PCI.

C) For State Universities / University Departments, admission may be allowed only the WBJEE Merit Rank along with their existing norms of percentage of domicile students and students from other States, fulfilling all the eligibility criteria of the Regulatory Authorities.

All the above types of candidates must fulfill the eligibility criteria for admission to B.Pharm course as outlined by the regulatory authority, i.e. PCI.

For filling up the vacant EWS seats at the institute level, the institutes have to strictly follow the Gazette Notification bearing no. 628-Edn (CS) dated 18.09.2023 in the following manner:

“In continuation to this Department’s Memo No. 339-Edn(CS)/OM-74L/2023 dated 26.05.2023 and published in the Kolkata Gazette, extraordinary, Part-I, on 26.05.2023, after clause 3, insert the following clauses:

The District Magistrate and the District Reservation Commissioner shall be the authority in respect of Higher Educational Institutions within their administrative jurisdiction for approval of filling up of the unfilled reserved seats for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) category by the candidates from General Merit list, subject to fulfillment of conditions laid down in clause 3(e) of memorandum No. 339-Edn (CS)/OM-74L/2023 dated 26.05.2023.

In respect of institute situated in Kolkata as defined in in the Kolkata Municipal Corporation Act, 1980, the commissioner for reservation and ex-officio secretary in the Backward Classes Welfare Department and the Joint Commissioner for reservation and ex-officio joint secretary, Backward Classes Welfare Department shall be the authorities for granting such permission for filling up the vacancies for such seats reserved for EWS category by the candidates from General Merit list, subject to fulfillment of conditions laid down in clause 3(e) of Memo No.339-Edn(CS)/OM-74L/2023 dated 26.05.2023.

Such filling up of vacant seats for EWS category shall be made only from those left out candidates in the general merit list for admission prepared by the concerned institute and no new candidate outside the state panel shall be considered for such admission. Until and unless the separate merit list of Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) candidates is exhausted by filling up of available seats for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) category as per Memo No.339-Edn (CS)/OM-74L/2023 dated 26.05.2023, de-reservation proposal shall not be entertained.”

The intending candidates are hereby instructed to present themselves in person to the individual institutes after careful consideration of the vacant seats as detailed here under:


