
This is for information to all concerned that after completion of Counseling by West Bengal Joint Entrance Examination Board 2025, some of the seats still remained vacant in B.Sc. Nursing, Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing, M.Sc. Nursing and GNM Nursing in the Non Government Nursing Institutions in West Bengal.

Now, in order to fill up the vacant seats in B.Sc. Nursing Course, candidates having Rank either in JENPAS-UG 2025 or NEET-UG, 2025 having domicile in West Bengal will be allowed for admission in the Non-Government Institutions to fill up the vacant seats in B.Sc. Nursing Course. However they should fulfil the minimum academic and eligibility criteria for appearing in JENPAS-UG, 2025 and having the eligibility criteria as prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council (INC).

The Vacant Seats of Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing and M.Sc. Nursing in Non – Government Institutions will be filled up by candidates appeared in JEPBN 2025 and JEMScN, 2025 and having the eligibility criteria as prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council (INC).

In GNM Course candidates having qualification of 10+2 passed, having domicile in West Bengal and having the eligibility criteria as prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council (INC) are allowed to take admission in Non-Govt. Institutions.

This will be applicable only for the academic session 2025-2026.

question-wise calculation of the score. If the candidate wishes to make a physical representation, it is allowed till noon on the next working day of result publication. **The Board will not entertain query after that.**

- k) A candidate can calculate his/her score from his/her machine read response and published final answer keys. However, if any candidate needs a calculation sheet from the Board, he/she will have to apply to the Board with a demand draft of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five hundred only) in favor of 'West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board' payable at Kolkata. But this facility will be available only till 60 days after the declaration of result or till the counseling is over, whichever is later.

**N.B.** – As per INC Guideline, the minimum qualifying criteria of Entrance Test to admission to B.Sc. Nursing is as Under:

General – 50<sup>th</sup> Percentile,

General PwD – 45<sup>th</sup> Percentile,

SC/ST/OBC – 40<sup>th</sup> Percentile

#### 17.0 General rules about documents

- a) Whenever and wherever a candidate produces documents like confirmation page, admit card, rank card, caste/ category/ domicile/ income certificate etc., he/she must produce it in original. **Documents generated by the portal must be printed by using the 'PRINT' link provided for the purpose. Screen shots, photographs of the screen, images captured/stored by/in mobile phone etc. are not acceptable as any valid document.**

**It is very much pertinent to mention here that Caste Certificates of the candidates will be verified by Officers nominated by BCWD, Government of West Bengal both for pre-choice fill -up verification and also during post allotment admission process. This will abide by the final order/Judgment passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Special Leave to Appeal (C) No(s).17422/2025(Arising out of impugned final judgment and order dated 17-06-2025 in CAN No. 1 / 2025 passed by the High Court at Calcutta.**

- b) Confirmation page, admit card, rank card etc. contains some personal information as given by the candidate during online application. As such, the Board is in no way responsible for any mistake in it due to incorrect entry given by the candidate.
- c) **All verifications are done during counselling. Hence candidates cannot assume that the personal information shown in the confirmation page, admit card, rank card etc., are accepted or approved by the Board.**
- d) In case the candidate faces any problem during admission in any institute or thereafter due to any mistake committed by him/her in providing such personal information during online application, **the Board is not able to render any help e.g., issuing any letter of correction etc.** The candidate must take necessary actions at his/her end with the institute, where he/she takes admission.
- e) Confirmation page and admit card cannot be downloaded after the examination. Rank card cannot be downloaded after the counselling is over. Candidates must preserve such documents safely.

## ADMISSION TERMS AND CONDITION

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year in which admission is sought. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years.
2. Minimum Educational Qualification
  - a) Candidate with Science who have passed the qualifying 12<sup>th</sup> Standard examination (10+2) and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together. The candidate must have pass marks in English.
  - b) Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government having Science subjects and English only.
  - c) English is a compulsory subject in 10+2 for being eligible for admission to B.Sc. (Nursing).
3. Colour blind candidates are eligible provided that colour corrective contact lens and spectacles are worn by such candidates.
4. Candidate shall be medically fit.
5. Married candidates are also eligible for admission.
6. Students shall be admitted once in a year.
7. Selection of candidates should be based on the merit of the **entrance examination**. Entrance test\*\* shall comprise of:
  - a) Aptitude for Nursing 20 marks
  - b) Physics 20 marks
  - c) Chemistry 20 marks
  - d) Biology 20 marks
  - e) English 20 marks

The minimum qualifying criteria of entrance test to admission to B.Sc. Nursing is as under:

General	50 <sup>th</sup> percentile
General - PwD	45 <sup>th</sup> percentile
SC/ST/OBC	40 <sup>th</sup> percentile

\*\*Entrance test shall be conducted by University/State Government.
